(DP World)</p> | <p>"The goods warehoused in SEZ/FTWZ whether brought from outside the country or from DTA may either be cleared into the DTA, exported out of the country, or even destroyed in certain cases. Whenever a Bill of entry is filed for clearance of goods to DTA, the clearance is made adhering to appropriate acts and rules as applicable along with payment of customs duties. The minutes issued by a customs formation is binding on the formation alone and not on other formations. However, it is informed that whenever the goods are imported for clearance to DTA at FTWZs/SEZs under MEPZ SEZ, all the requisite procedures are followed, including for PQ clearance."</p> |
