

The Unit Approval Committee confirmed and ratified the Minutes of the UAC meetings held on 17.06.2022 and 30.06.2022.

6.1 Request of M/s. Threlakshaa Technologies Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in KGISL SEZ, Coimbatore

The proposal of M/s. Threlakshaa Technologies Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in KGISL SEZ, Coimbatore for 'IT Consulting Services – CPC Code 83131, IT Design and Development Services for applications – CPC Code 83141, Software Originals – CPC Code 83143, Architectural Services for residential building projects – CPC Code 83212, Architectural Services for non-residential building projects – CPC Code 83213, Online Games – CPC Code 84391 and Online Software – CPC Code 84392' with a projected investment of ₹ 502.00 lakh and projected NFEE of ₹ 1,384.34 lakh over a period of 5 years with an employment generation for 50 persons was examined by the Unit Approval Committee.

After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 18(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.



6.2 Request of M/s. Connected Value Health Solutions Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in KGISL SEZ, Coimbatore

The proposal of M/s. Connected Value Health Solutions Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in KGISL SEZ, Coimbatore for 'Other Application Software Package' with a projected investment of ₹ 208 lakh and projected NFEE of ₹ 2,978.03 lakh over a period of 5 years with an employment generation for 250 persons was examined by the Unit Approval Committee.

After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 18(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

6.3 Request of M/s. Prochant India Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in KGISL SEZ, Coimbatore



After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 18(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

6.4 Request of M/s. Cameron Manufacturing India Private Limited, a Unit at Tidel Park in ELCOT SEZ, Coimbatore for acquiring additional space

The proposal of M/s. After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 18(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.


6.6 Request of M/s. Ladera Technology Private Limited for setting up a new Unit in DLF Info City Chennai SEZ, Ramapuram, Chennai



6.8 Request of M/s. DLF Assets Limited, Co-Developer of DLF Info City SEZ, Chennai for procurement of materials


M/s. DLF Assets Limited, Co-Developer of DLF Info City SEZ, Chennai has requested for approval for procuring goods through indigenous source (5 Nos. of Battery Operated Vehicles) for their authorised operations.

Their request was placed in the UAC meeting held on 17.06.2022 and it was rejected since there is no provision for approval of such items in the SEZ Rules and was communicated to the Co-Developer. The Co-Developer has again requested this office for approval of procurement of Battery Operated Cars at an estimated value of ₹ 6 lakh with a duty forgone value of ₹ 1.08 lakh with the copies of approvals given by this office based on the UAC meetings held on 24.01.2018 and 22.08.2019. The Unit Approval Committee once again re-examined the request of the Co-Developer.

After detailed deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal of the Co-Developer in terms of provisions contained in Rule 12(2) of SEZ Rules subject to the condition that the Battery Operated Vehicles should be used within the SEZ premises only and it should be used for transporting employees working in the SEZ from the main gate to their place of work in the SEZ.

6.9 Ratification of approval given to M/s. Progressive Industries for Manufacture and export of additional products and inclusion of additional product in their LOA under broad-banding

M/s. Progressive Industries, a Unit in MEPZ at Tambaram having LOA No.8/152/2011/SEZ dated 30.03.022 which was approved for manufacture and export of Moulded Components, Machined Components, Machineries, Mechanical appliances and parts, Electrical equipments and parts and Designing of products, has requested permission for manufacture and export of following products:

After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 19(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006 subject to the condition that the Unit shall get Licence from the authorities concerned for exporting the above item.

The Unit has submitted following revised projections on account of increase in space:



After deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 19(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

6.15 Request from M/s. Zwilling Kitchen India Private Limited, a Unit in New Chennai Township SEZ, Cheyyur for setting up a Canteen facility

M/s. Zwilling Kitchen India Private Limited, a Unit in New Chennai Township SEZ, Cheyyur has requested permission of this office for setting up a Canteen facility in the SEZ in an area of 7,723.53 sq.ft. in its premises. The Unit has also submitted No Objection Certificate from the Developer and approval letter from the Inspector of Factories and Contract with the Vendor with GST and FSSAI Licence.



The proposal of the Unit for setting up the Canteen was examined by the Unit Approval Committee. After deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal in terms of Instruction No.95 dated 11.06.2019 issued by Department of Commerce with the following conditions:

- 1) The Canteen shall be used exclusively by the employees of the Unit;
- 2) No cooking shall be allowed inside the Cafeteria except using electrical cooking gadgets for heating sandwiches, tea and coffee and cooling juices, etc.;
- 3) The Unit shall have fire alarm, detection, prevention and protection systems as prescribed by the National Building Code;
- 4) Permission shall be received from Fire Department, Director of Industries, District Collector and Municipal Office and
- 5) The Unit shall not claim any tax exemption for the materials used in the Cafeteria.

6.16 Request of M/s. Omega Healthcare Management Services Private Limited, a Unit in IG3 Infra SEZ, Thoraipakkam, Chennai for acquiring additional space


The proposal of M/s. Omega Healthcare Management Services Private Limited, a Unit in IG3 Infra SEZ, Thoraipakkam, Chennai for acquiring 22,858 sq.ft. at 2nd Floor, Module 3, Phase-II, South Block in the SEZ for training the employees was examined by the Unit Approval Committee. The Unit has stated that there is no change in the projections.

After deliberations, the Committee approved the proposal in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 19(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

6.17 Request from M/s. New Chennai Township SEZ Private Limited, Cheyyur for procurement of materials

M/s. New Chennai Township SEZ Private Limited, Developer of the SEZ (Multi Sector SEZ) at Cheyyur, has submitted for approval of the Unit Approval Committee, a list of indigenous materials for an estimated value of ₹ 1,249.08 lakh with a duty forgone value of ₹ 224.83 lakh for its authorised operations viz., for construction of all types of buildings in Processing Area, construction of Science Park, Rainwater Plant, Water Treatment Plant and Sewage Treatment Plant. The list of materials has been certified by a Chartered Engineer. The request was examined by the Unit Approval Committee.

After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 12(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.



6.18 Request from M/s. New Chennai Township SEZ Private Limited, Cheyyur for procurement of materials

M/s. New Chennai Township SEZ Private Limited, Developer of the SEZ (Light Engineering SEZ), Cheyyur, has submitted for approval of the Unit Approval Committee, a list of indigenous materials for an estimated value of ₹ 506.55 lakh with a duty forgone value of ₹ 91.16 lakh for its authorised operations viz., for construction of all types of buildings in Processing Area, Rainwater Plant, Water Treatment Plant and Sewage Treatment Plant. The list of materials has been certified by a Chartered Engineer. The request was examined by the Unit Approval Committee. After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 12(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

6.19 Request of M/s. DLF Power & Services Limited, Co-Developer of DLF Info City SEZ, Chennai for procurement of additional quantity of Duty free HSD for the year 2022-23

M/s. DLF Power & Services Limited, Co-Developer of DLF Info City SEZ Chennai has requested approval for procurement of duty free HSD for the year 2022-23. The request of the Co-Developer was placed in the Unit Approval Committee in its meeting held on 11.04.2022 and permitted the Co-Developer to procure 6.38 KL for the year 2022-23 after taking into account the stock of 162.07 KL in hand. The Co-Developer made a request again to this office to allow them to procure 168.45 KL without deducting the stock in hand. It was again placed in the UAC meeting held on 17.06.2022 and the UAC has decided that the permission given by the Office is correct and also directed the ADC concerned to get the details of previous years consumption of HSD, Number of Units working at present and employees and the justification for additional quantity of duty free HSD and the exact quantity of duty free HSD requirement for the year 2022-23 from the Co-Developer. Accordingly, the Co-Developer has requested permission of this office for procurement of 500 KL duty free HSD for the year 2022-23.



The Co-Developer has also stated that the consumption of diesel was low for the last 2-3 years on account of covid-19 pandemic situation and the situation has improved now for the employees of respective Units coming to the office premises for work; the Co-Developer has informed that at present 90 Units are functioning and 60,000 employees have reported for work out of 92,000 employees in the 97 Units housed in the SEZ. With the return of majority of the employees to the workplace since April 2022, the energy requirement has reached back to its peak demand resulting in stocking more High Speed Diesel to cater to the increased need for generation of power and proper upkeep of their power generation plant. The Co-Developer has also stated that they are required to provide uninterrupted power supply not only to the Units but also for common areas to run Elevators, Air-conditioners, Servers, UPS Batteries and Housekeeping equipments for upkeep of the building including clients' critical requirements of power.

The Co-Developer has also submitted that the Metro Rail Project connecting Alandur to Poonamallee via Porur would pass through the Mount Ponnammalle (Poovirundhavalli) Road in front of their SEZ and there is a 110 KV underground cable connecting Guindy Sub-Station with DLF. In case of any damage caused to the underground 110 KV cable owing to construction activities, it might take at least 7 to 10 days to restore electric power to the SEZ. Considering such unforeseen circumstances, they need at least 100 KL of diesel per day to provide the full load of 30 MVA to the SEZ.



The request of the Co-Developer was again re-examined by the Unit Approval Committee given the reasons cited with facts and circumstances. After detailed deliberations, the Committee decided to approve the procurement of diesel without any deduction (only 330.52 KL of duty free HSD for the year 2022-23) as a onetime measure in accordance with the principles of Ease of Doing Business with the following conditions;

- 1) The Co-Developer shall furnish month wise consumption of diesel for the year 2022-23.
- 2) The Co-Developer shall furnish the number of Units functioning month wise for the year 2022-23.
- 3) The Co-Developer shall furnish the number of employees reported for work month wise for the year 2022-23.


6.20 Ratification of approval given to M/s. Visteon Technical and Services Centre Private Limited, a Unit in Gateway Office Parks SEZ, Perungalathur, Chengalpattu district for acquiring additional space

M/s. Visteon Technical and Services Centre Private Limited, a Unit in Gateway Office Parks SEZ, Perungalathur, Chengalpattu district has requested approval for acquiring 4,500 sq.ft. (50 seats) for a period of 60 days from 11.07.2022 to 10.09.2022 for providing training/induction of employees. In view of the urgency, approval of the Competent Authority was given to the Unit for acquiring additional space on 11.07.2022. The Committee ratified the approval given by the Competent Authority to the Unit for acquiring additional space.

6.21 Request of M/s. ZF Commercial Vehicle Control Systems India Limited at Mahindra World City SEZ for clearance of Dies to DTA without payment of duty




After deliberations, the Committee approved the same in terms of provisions contained in Rule 12(2) of SEZ Rules, 2006.
